Attached please find the new County cattle guard frames and cattle guards specifications.

New Cattle Guard Frames and Cattle Guards,

New cattle guard frame should be at least 20 ft. X 6 ft. The frame height should be 1 ft. or 2 ft., depending on road conditions. The cattle guard itself should fit inside frame and be removable, for cleaning and repair in the future.

Replacement Cattle guard Frames and Cattle guards,

Replacement cattle guard frame length should be at least 2 ft. wider than existing road width. It should be wide enough to sit on top of existing cement frame, depending on condition of old cement frame at time of replacement. The frame height should be 1 ft.

The cattle guard itself should fit inside frame and be removable, for cleaning and repair in the future.
